

## CONDITIONAL RELEVANCE

1. Husband Plaintiff sues Defendant Insurance Company which failed to pay when Wife died. D alleges suicide.

Evidence at issue: Page allegedly from W's diary indicating serious depression two days before W's death.

2. D, driving a green Mini-van struck Plaintiff's car. P sues.

Evidence at issue: Testimony of W that he saw a green Mini-van driving at a fast rate of speed one-half mile from the collision site.

3. P, wife sues D private aircraft company. Husband died flying one of D's planes with mechanical defect. D alleges assumption of risk.

Evidence at issue: Testimony of aircraft mechanic that just before H flew the plane, the aircraft mechanic stated to several persons that the defect existed.
